

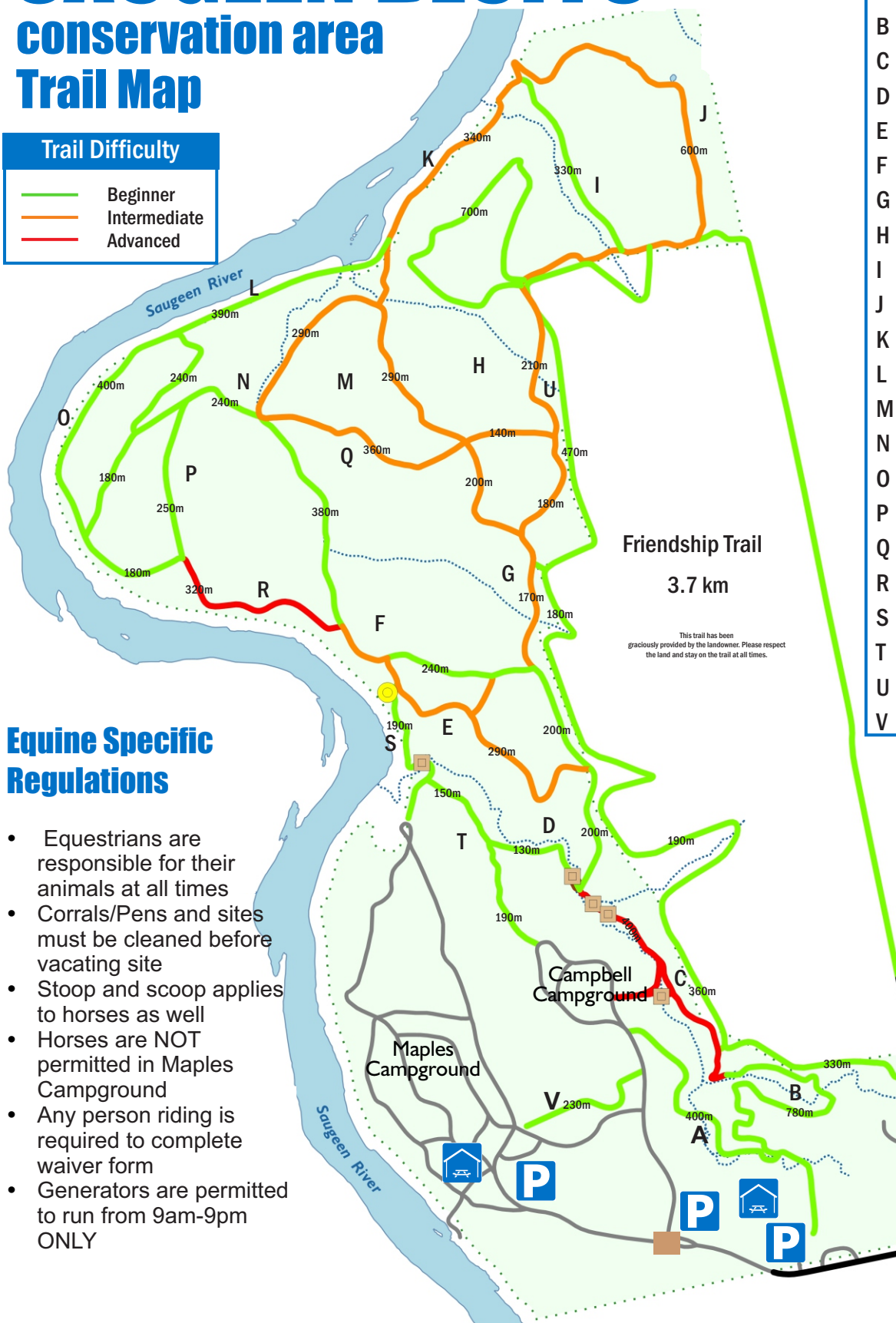

Equine Specific Regulations

- Equestrians are responsible for their animals at all times
- Corrals/Pens and sites must be cleaned before vacating site
- Stoop and scoop applies to horses as well
- Horses are NOT permitted in Maples Campground
- Any person riding is required to complete waiver form
- Generators are permitted to run from 9am-9pm ONLY

A complete copy of the Conservation Area Regulations is available at the gatehouse.

Violations may result in eviction from the park.

Campground Rules and Regulations

- Check-in time is after 2:00 p.m. and Check-out time is before 12:00 p.m.
- Permits must be displayed on dashboards and shown to gate staff upon entry.
- Pets must be on a leash not exceeding 2 metres (6 feet) and must be under control at all times.
- Poop and scoop applies at all times.
- Pets are not to make excessive noise or disturb other persons and are not permitted in the beach area.
- The permit holder is responsible for the conduct and behaviour of their family and guests.
- Rowdy behaviour, excessive noise or swearing will not be tolerated.
- Campers evicted from the campground for any circumstance are not eligible for reimbursement.
- A maximum of 6 persons are permitted per campsite.
- A maximum of 3 pieces of shelter equipment is allowed per campsite.
- If the campsite is left unkempt, a clean-up fee will be applied to your credit card.
- Alcohol / Cannabis may only be consumed on a registered campsite.
- Quiet time is from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. All electronic devices are to be turned off.
- Generators are NOT permitted in the campground, except in the equestrian and group areas, operated from 9am to 9pm.
- Drivers must obey the Highway Traffic Act, posted speed limits, signs and be aware of pedestrians.
- Fireworks are prohibited by regulation, except for specific designated holidays and only if approved and under the direction of the SVCA staff.
- All Terrain Vehicles (ATV), Golf Carts etc. are prohibited in the campground.
- Outside firewood is NOT permitted to be brought within the campground.
- Natural objects (trees, plants, rocks etc.) are NOT to be removed or damaged.
